### St. Florian Continues to Raise Funds to Purchase Boiler for their Church

Since it's opening in 1905, St. Florian, a small parish located at 13145 S. Houston Ave. in Chicago, has grown in size and become much more diversified. With 500 parishioners and counting, current pastor, Fr. Robert Marchwiany, has done a tremendous job encouraging people and families to continue attending Mass and become involved in ministries and events.

"Our parish family and staff have grown to love and appreciate the time and hard work he puts into making our parish a second home for our parishioners."

The parish is currently continuing to raise funds towards their goal which will allow them to purchase a new boiler. The boiler is at the end of its life and broke down a couple of times this past winter. The parish hopes a new boiler will help them continue operating during the cold winter months.

## Multiple Gift Options Available to Campaign Donors



In addition to making a one-time gift, there are additional gift options donors can use to continue generously giving to the campaign. Please know that every contribution is extremely appreciated and will help ensure all parishes in the archdiocese are strong and vibrant communities of faith.

#### **Charitable Gift Annuity**

A gift annuity with To Teach Who Christ Is will provide you with a fixed income and an opportunity to support the campaign on an ongoing basis. When you establish a charitable gift annuity, you receive fixed payments for life based on age (a portion of which is tax free) and receive a charitable deduction on income taxes. Campaign donors are able to fund their annuity with cash or securities. There are one or two life policies and deferred annuities available.

#### **Bequests**

Do you have a will or living trust? To ensure that your legacy is secure, you must have a valid will or living trust drafted.

If you choose to make a gift as part of your living trust or will, please consider leaving a bequest to the Church through To Teach Who Christ Is.

Your gift may take many different forms:

- A specific dollar amount. "I give \$5,000 to ..."
- A specific property or asset. "I give 100 shares of ABC Inc. common stock to ..."
- A percentage of your estate. "I give 10 percent of my estate to ..."
- The remainder of your estate after your debts, estate administration expenses and other bequests. "I give the remainder of my estate to ..."
